  - a-2: Improvement in traffic flow (<200 words) Reduced congestion, delays, etc.
  - a-3: Improvement in road safety (<200 words) Reduced road trauma (fatalities, injuries, etc.).
- b. Technical excellence (<200 words)

The development and implementation of innovative design and construction methods and the cost savings associated with the use of these innovations compared to traditional design and construction approaches.

c. Environmental awareness (<200 words)

Minimization of the impact of the project on the lifestyle of the local community (land acquisition, noise, greenhouse gas emissions, etc.).

Category II (community road)

- a. Social effectiveness and impact
  - a-1: Economic development of community and rural (<200 words)</li>
    Economic benefits compared to the cost of the project: stimulation of economic growth, local employment, improvement in lifestyle, amenity, etc.
  - a-2: Improvement in traffic flow (<200 words) Improved access, reduced travel time
  - a-3: Improvement in road safety (<200 words) Reduced road trauma (fatalities, injuries, etc.).

- b. Technical excellence (<200 words)</li>
  The adaptation of traditional design and construction methods for low-cost community roads operating under limited budgets
- c. Environmental friendliness (<200 words)</li>
  Minimization of the impact of the project on the lifestyle of the local community (land acquisition, noise, greenhouse gas emissions, etc.).
